As a Tax Clinic Volunteer, you will have no direct interaction with participants unless you opt to volunteer at Bowmont Commons for the drop-in sessions.

- Exercise the utmost respect and confidentiality when handling sensitive information.
- Ensure that the tax filings adhere to the latest government requirements.

- Community Volunteer Income Tax Program (CVITP) is required.
- Demonstrated proficiency in tax preparation from previous experience.
- Exemplary attention to detail.
- Proven ability to handle time-sensitive information with accuracy and efficiency.
- A welcoming, cheery, and friendly person full of curiosity and caring.
- A comfort, openness, and respect for working with people as they are, including diverse life experiences, culture, identity, beliefs, and values.
